Products of China Temporarily Regain Eligibility for De Minimis Duty-Free Treatment

President Trump has issued an executive order that duty-free treatment under de minimis has been temporarily reinstated on shipments under \$800.00 due to processing systems not being in place to properly process and collect the duty on the packages with Chinese goods. This change is temporary and will end when the Secretary of Commerce notifies the President that the systems are in place and able to process the entries and collections.
